

Activities:

Game Drives exploring Tarangire National Park (NP), Serengeti NP, Ngorongoro Crater, a visit to Haadzabe Bushmen and to Kilimanjaro NP. Inspection of the major lodges/camps in the Northern Safari Circuit. Meetings with Tanzanian Tour Operators and Lodge & Camp owners.





Itinerary:

Day 01: Kilimanjaro Airport – Mount Kilimanjaro

Morning/midday arrival at Kilimanjaro International Airport; meet & greet by the FAM trip Safari ground handler – TATO member, and transfer to your accommodation in the vicinity of Mount Kilimanjaro. Dinner and overnight in the Kilimanjaro area on a half-board basis.

Day 02: Roof of Africa: Majestic Kilimanjaro - Arusha town

After an early breakfast, enjoy a short trek on the foot slopes of Mount Kilimanjaro, lasting approximately 1-2 hours. This trek will be guided by a certified mountain guide from a recognized mountain trekking operator – a TATO member. With good weather, there is a high chance of viewing the Roof of Africa.

Following an early or packed lunch, transfer to Arusha town.

In the afternoon, participate in a networking event organized by the Tanzania Association of Tour Operators (TATO), providing agents with the opportunity to meet tour operators and lodge/camp owners.

Dinner and overnight in Arusha on a half-board basis.

Day 03: Arusha - Discover Tarangire

After breakfast, depart for Tarangire National Park for a game drive.

During the dry season from July to October, the Tarangire River serves as the sole water source within the National Park, attracting animals such as elephants, giraffes, zebras, buffalo, and many more to its banks. Naturally, predators are not far behind!

Hotel inspection with lunch.

Transfer to your accommodation.

Dinner and overnight in the Tarangire area on a full-board basis.

Day 04: Climb the Rift Valley Escarpment to the Serengeti

After breakfast, transfer by road to Serengeti National Park. Stop at the viewpoint in the Ngorongoro Conservation Area and enjoy the breathtaking view of the Ngorongoro Crater.

Next, visit the Olduvai Gorge Museum, where you will witness the birthplace of humanity and unravel the mysteries of our evolutionary past, followed by a picnic lunch at Naabi Kopjes.

Embark on game drives in the Serengeti National Park, on the lookout for the Serengeti Great Migration, an annual natural spectacle where millions of wildebeest, zebras and other herbivores migrate across the Serengeti ecosystem in search of fresh grazing lands, followed by the predators.

Transfer to your accommodation.

Dinner and overnight in the Serengeti on a full-board basis.

Day 05: Birds-eye view of the Serengeti

Early morning Hot-Air Balloon Safari with a champagne bush breakfast.

Game drives exploring the remarkable plant and animal life of the Serengeti, moving south. In the afternoon, explore the Ndutu area of the Ngorongoro Conservation Area.

Hot or packed lunch.

Transfer to your accommodation.

Dinner and overnight in South Serengeti/Ngorongoro Conservation Area on a full-board basis.

Day 06: Explore Ngorongoro Crater

After breakfast, drive to the Ngorongoro Crater. Descend into the crater and explore Ngorongoro with morning game drives.

The Ngorongoro Crater offers a wide variety of animals due to the permanent availability of grass and water. Keep an eye out for the 'Biq Five': lion, leopard, rhino, elephant, and buffalo.

Enjoy an inspection with lunch on the Ngorongoro Crater rim.

Transfer to your accommodation.

Dinner and overnight stay in Ngorongoro/Lake Eyasi on a full-board basis.



Day 07: "The Last of The Firsts" Haadzabe Bushmen – Arusha town

After very early breakfast a drive to Lake Eyasi, where Haadzabe tribe, also named "the Bushmen", reside. You will join them in their morning hunt for food; learn how to make fire without matches; and a few words of their click language.

Hot or packed lunch.

Day 07: Safari Ends

Transfer to Kilimanjaro International Airport, departing in the afternoon/evening hours. End of Service.
